



### **Measure S**

Planned library Improvements in Capitola and Live Oak – part of the 10-branch Santa Cruz Public Libraries system







### Capitola

- Replace inadequate, cramped, temporary facilities with a modern, permanent library
- Provide safe space for teens after school, including area for homework and tutoring
- Provide space for wide range of community programs serving seniors, children and community members of all ages
- Community input on design process and features

### Vision Statement: Provide multi-use learning spaces accessible to all

### Santa Cruz Public Libraries – Live Oak Annex Project Goals

Create a **learning environment** which serves **all ages** and provides **gathering spaces** which encourage **intergenerational activities** 

Provide **learning facilities** not available at the Existing Live Oak Library branch that are **free to the public** 

Locate the facility in a **central location** accessible to the Live Oak Community

Design the facility to **function in partnership** with other community organizations maximizing the opportunities for **collaborative and engaging programming** as well as providing the **most efficient use of resources and personnel** 

**Leverage past investment** in existing community institutions

- Building human capital, relationships, and knowledge networks in the community
- Parents, Children,
   Students, Teens,
   Immigrants, Retirees, Job
   Seekers, Entrepreneurs
- Librarian as a guide: coach, mentor, facilitator, teacher

- Library as family room of the community
- Physical and digital community anchor
- Strengthen community identity
- Space is informed by reduction in physical materials, greater customer mobility, desire for more collaboration
- Flexible and adaptable spaces
- Spaces with tools and technology

- The Library is a platform upon which the community builds the services it wants
- Library as a central hub for learning and community connections
- Access to databases, homework assistance, employment resources, e-books, digital reference
- New services: workspaces for mobile workers, video conferencing, maker/creator spaces, digital media creation







EXISTING CENTER RENOVATED TO LIBRARY AND FLEXIBLE PROGRAM ROOM WITH NEW ENTRY








## **Option B**

LIBRARY ADDITION AT FRONT OF BUILDING AND EXPANDED ENTRANCE



PROGRAM ROOM












