Please complete the Santa Cruz City Council Library Subcommittee survey, which has a **deadline** of June 8th at 10:00 AM. We strongly advise you take the survey *no later* than *June 7th at 5:00 PM*.

The Council's Library Subcommittee had its final public meeting before it evaluates the options for the Downtown Library -- and makes recommendation(s) to the full City Council.

If this survey is worth anything, then your comments about evaluation criteria **will make a difference**, because the Jayson Architecture proposal <u>meets or exceeds the 55 individual criteria</u> that the Subcommittee is considering. Jayson is so much more than a renovation! The Jayson option **rebuilds** the library, creating a shiny new two story structure that includes all new interiors and furnishings (including computers and book shelves).
