The Done Deal is Done.

The Library Subcommittee met on Friday, June 12, and had voted for Group 4's proposals before noon!

TWO ACTIONS

First, FLOOD THE CITY COUNCIL -

imploring them **not to approve** the Mixed-Use project and instead vote to pursue the Jayson Architecture reconstruction proposal of the downtown library -- because it will cost the City less, planning can be implemented immediately, and it will provide a modernized and beautiful library for everyone! Send your email no later than June 18 in order to be most effective.

Second, plan to attend a **Sidewalk Rally at the Downtown Library on Wednesday June 17 at 2:30 pm**. Meet-up at 2:15 *on the sidewalk that faces City Hall, to share your passion* for keeping the library at its present location -- beautifully remodeled and rebuilt. The Jayson Architecture proposal is so much more than just a "renovation."

Home made signs are welcome, though not necessary.

Examples:

- Keep Our Library Here!

- Don't Move Our Library - Make it beautiful here!
- Measure S \$\$\$ for our library here, not stuck in a 6 story building!

We hope there will be a great diversity of people at this rally, including all ages -- to show that the library serves all of us. Bring your children and grandchildren if you are able.

Please observe social distancing. Bring a mask or bandana. We'll spread out all over the sidewalk, making this a *safe place for all*.

After our rally at the library (perhaps 30 minutes duration), those who wish can join a procession to the sidewalk opposite the Farmers' Market to rally for keeping the Market there, as part of a permanent public plaza, an open air Downtown Commons.
